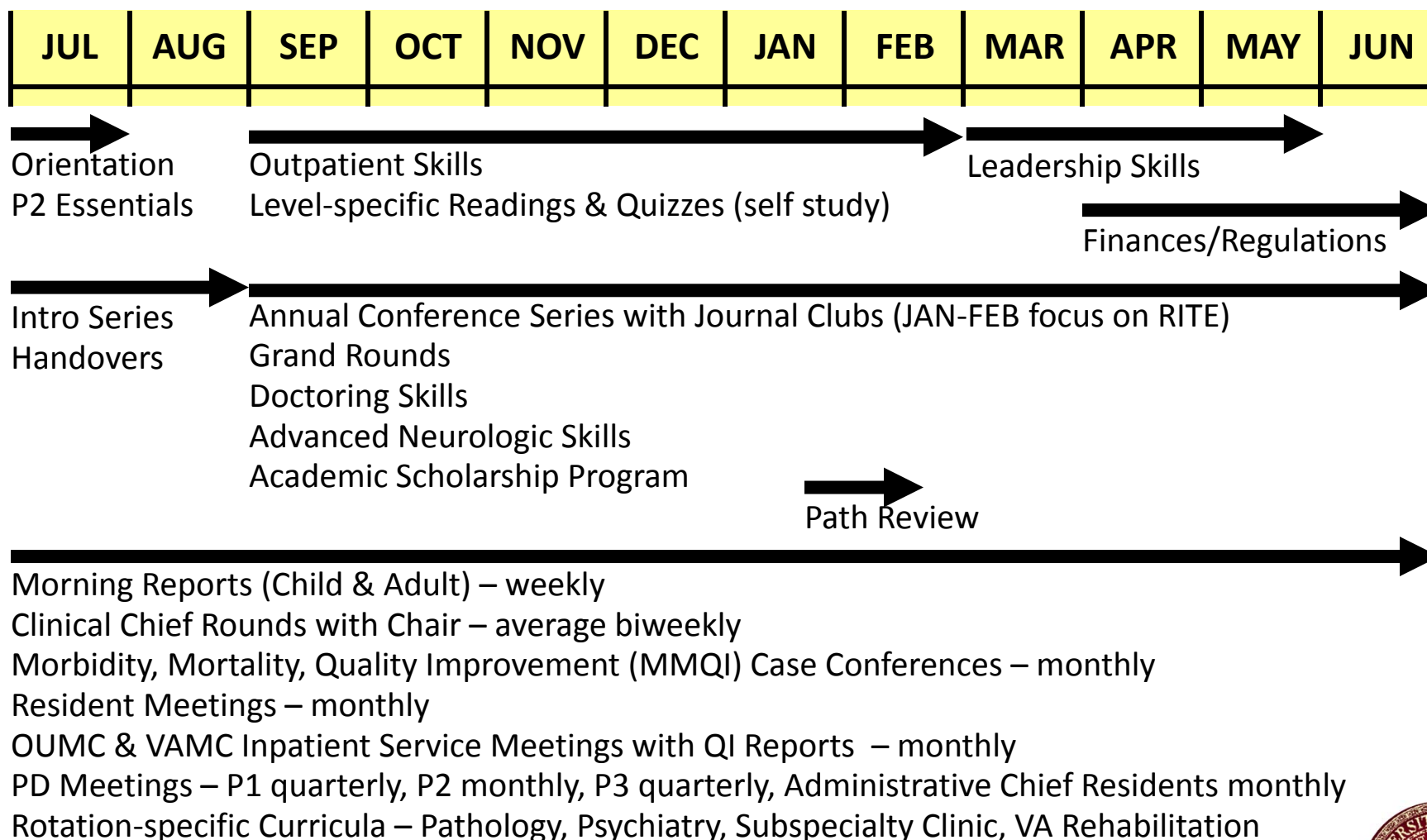
OU NEUROLOGY RESIDENCY: GLOBAL LEARNING OBJECTIVES

- Created & revised annually by PEC, including program director, chair, & chief resident

OU NEUROLOGY RESIDENCY: ORIENTATION

JUL

- Series of 8 lectures first two weeks of the year:
 - Administrative Chief Resident Orientation
 - Residency Program Curriculum 1 & 2
 - VAMC Residents' Operation Plan
 - Sleep Deprivation & Time on Active Duty
 - AIDET & Neurologic History-Taking Skills
 - Competency-Based Education for Physician Trainees
 - Medical Student Curricula & Residents as Teachers



OU NEUROLOGY RESIDENCY: P2 ESSENTIALS

JUL

- Key components of M3 clerkship curriculum for P2s
- Essential neurologic exam – 50 items, standardized techniques
- Aphasia & coma standardized patient (SP) sessions
- Brain imaging – CT & MRI
- Case-based learning – 20 key cases
 - AIS, SAH, BPPV, migraine, sleep apnea, MS, bacterial meningitis
 - GBS, myasthenia gravis, cervical & LS radiculopathies, neuralgia
 - Alzheimer dz, Parkinson dz, complex-partial szs, GTC status, delirium
 - Subdural hematoma, herniation, spinal cord compression
- Essential neurologic findings – 26
 - Aphasia (E/R), neglect, dysarthria, swollen disk, hemianopsia, CN3, CN 6, CN7
 - Pronator drift, atrophy/fascics, wrist & foot drops, ankle clonus, Babinski
 - Tremor (resting, essential, intention), choreoathetosis, gait (ataxia & Parkinson)
 - Sensory deficits (level, distal, C6, L5), Romberg



OU NEUROLOGY RESIDENCY:

INTRODUCTION TO NEUROLOGY SERIES

JUL-AUG

- Core knowledge & skills best learned early in year
- 5-6 sessions/week
 - Mon 8A & 12P, Tue 8A, Wed 12P, Fri 8A, 3rd Fri 12P
- Representative topics during sessions
 - Basic science – neuroanatomy
 - Focused exams – NIHSS & other stroke scales, coma, brain death, muscle/nerve, infant, language, mental status
 - PBLI & SBP – evidence-based medicine, informed consent, research pearls, quality improvement , utilization review, patient safety, stroke center performance measures
 - Key cases – transient neurologic deficits, acute ischemic stroke, status epilepticus, headache, neuromuscular emergencies, cerebral vein thrombosis, cerebral herniation, medical care of NSICU patient
 - Key skills – communication, lumbar puncture, brain & spine imaging
 - Key articles – stroke, dementia, antiepileptic drugs, multiple sclerosis, Parkinson disease, neuromuscular disorders, neuro-oncology



OU NEUROLOGY RESIDENCY: HANDOVER SKILLS TRAINING

JUL-AUG

- Formative assessments of oral and written communication skills re: patient care
- 7-8 sessions integrated into “Introduction to Neurology” series
 - Lecture on “Neurologic Communication”
 - Oral handovers – timed presentations with feedback from peers & faculty
 - Written handovers – submissions reviewed anonymously with feedback and evaluations by peers & faculty



OU NEUROLOGY RESIDENCY:

SEP-FEB

LEVEL-SPECIFIC READINGS & QUIZZES

- Self-study reading & quizzes aimed at providing residents with medical knowledge needed to pass the RITE and boards
- Participation is voluntary – no monitoring of reading or quizzes
- Recommended reading includes:
 - Neuroanatomy through Clinical Cases by Blumenfeld
 - AAN Continuum monographs, especially
 - Dementia
 - Movement Disorders
 - Neuro-oncology



OU NEUROLOGY RESIDENCY: OUTPATIENT SKILLS

SEP-FEB

- Interactive sessions in which expert clinicians offer practical approaches to patients in the clinic setting
- Monthly, 3rd Fri, 12P-1P
- Six sessions:
 - Overview/focused neuro exams
 - Radiculopathies
 - Myelopathies
 - Neuromuscular disorders
 - Dementia
 - Movement disorders



OU NEUROLOGY RESIDENCY: ANNUAL CONFERENCE SERIES (ACS)

SEP-JUN

- Comprehensive core curriculum lecture series
- Recurring annual series, organized by topic and based on ABPN recertification curriculum and global learning objectives
- Mon & Wed 12P + many Grand Rounds
- Incorporated journal clubs 2nd Mon of each month
- Post-lecture, anonymous, global assessment of session by residents
- In January & February, focused on RITE preparation



OU NEUROLOGY RESIDENCY: JOURNAL CLUBS

SEP-JUN

- Review of timely subspecialty articles with emphasis on methods; mix of key & random articles; 1 article/session
- Monthly, 2nd Monday 12P (incorporated into ACS)
- Topics include:
 - Stroke
 - Critical care
 - Neuromuscular diseases
 - Movement disorders
 - Neuro-oncology
 - Endovascular
 - Epilepsy
 - Neurobehavior
 - Neuroimmunology
 - Child neurology
- Two residents & random teams assigned in advance to opposing views lead discussion
- Two teams lead discussion without slides
- Fellows, faculty, & biostatistics professor judge & comment after resident discussion



OU NEUROLOGY RESIDENCY: GRAND ROUNDS

SEP-JUN

- Topics for faculty (CME credit) and trainees
- Weekly, Tue 8A
- Attended by faculty, residents, fellows, medical students, and other health professionals
- Some are part of residents' Annual Conference Series
- Some are supplemental topics pertinent to neurologists and include resident research presentations (Academic Scholarship Program)



OU NEUROLOGY RESIDENCY: DOCTORING SKILLS

SEP-JUN

- Interactive sessions often utilizing simulation (e.g., OSCE), focused on skills necessary to be an effective physician regardless of specialty (ACGME competencies “interpersonal & communication skills,” “professionalism,” & “systems-based practice”)
- Weekly, Fri 8A (8:00-9:00)
- Topics include:
 - History-taking skills, consultant etiquette
 - Patient & caregiver education, breaking bad news
 - Difficult patients & caregivers, patient nonadherence
 - Discharge planning, DNR, brain death, organ donation
 - Peer review, impaired physician, collegial conflict, medical errors
 - Clinical reasoning (including bias & heuristics)
 - Ethics, professionalism, disclosure, legal scenarios, risk management
 - Informed consent OSCEs, lecturing skills (OSTEs)



OU NEUROLOGY RESIDENCY: ADVANCED NEUROLOGIC SKILLS

SEP-JUN

- Recurrent annual curriculum providing introduction and progressive training of advanced skills pertinent to neurologists
- Weekly, Mon 8A
 - Week 1 – Angiography
 - Week 2 – EEG
 - Week 3 – EMG
 - Week 4 – Movement Disorders
 - Week 5 – Rehabilitation

OU NEUROLOGY RESIDENCY: ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

SEP-JUN

- Annual scholarly project by residents & fellows
- Projects differ by year:
 - P2 – case report
 - P3 – research project
 - P4 – QI team project
 - Fellow – research project
- All present at May Grand Rounds
 - Learning objectives
 - Study objectives
 - Introduction
 - Methods
 - Results
 - Conclusions
- Publish or present at national mtg
- Timeline
 - AUG: finalize project with mentor, statistician, study coordinator
 - OCT: report progress to Doc Skills
 - DEC: begin data collection
 - JAN: report progress to Doc Skills
 - MAR: present OSTE at Doc Skills
 - MAY: present at Grand Rounds
- Grand Rounds
 - P2 – 10 min per resident
 - P3 – 12 min per resident
 - P4 – 30 min per team (10/resident)
 - Fellow – 15 minutes per fellow



OU NEUROLOGY RESIDENCY: NEUROPATHOLOGY REVIEW

JAN-FEB

- Four lectures by neuropathologist
- Purpose is to serve as:
 - Annual pathology review for the residents
 - Preparation for the RITE in FEB
 - Preparation for the ABPN Neurology Boards
- Weekly in late JAN, early FEB, Thu 12P



OU NEUROLOGY RESIDENCY: LEADERSHIP SKILLS

MAR-MAY

- Readings and interactive sessions led by the chair, focusing on skills of a team & business leader
- 3rd and/or 5th Fri, 12P-1P
- Sessions consist of resident presentations & group discussion of reading assignments and their relation to current & future experiences
- Reading assignments from two texts
 - 7 Habits of Highly Effective People by Stephen R. Covey
 - E-Myth Revisited by Michael Gerber (re: small business)



OU NEUROLOGY RESIDENCY:

APR-JUN

HEALTHCARE FINANCES & REGULATIONS

- Lecture series on the practical aspects of the business & politics of medicine
- Tue 12P, weeks 2-4 *except during AAN meeting & end of academic year*
- 7 sessions covering the following topics:
 - ICD-10
 - Billing codes
 - ACA (Affordable Care Act) and meaningful use
 - ABPN MOC (maintenance of certification)
 - Business of academic medicine
 - Business of private practice
 - Wealth management



OU NEUROLOGY RESIDENCY: MORNING REPORTS

ALL YEAR

Both occur all year

■ Child Neurology Morning Report

- Weekly, Wed 8A
- Emphasis on differential diagnosis & evaluation
- Focus on P2s

■ Adult Neurology Morning Report

- Weekly, Thu 8A
- Emphasis on history-taking, localization, differential diagnosis (“how to think like a neurologist”)
- Focus on P2s



OU NEUROLOGY RESIDENCY: CLINICAL CHIEF ROUNDS

ALL YEAR

- Meetings of chair with chief residents on inpatient services to discuss difficult cases, systems/QI concerns, VIP patients
- Fri 1:30P-2:30P, when possible (average biweekly)
- Chair meets with the chief residents of the following services:
 - OU admit
 - OUMC consult
 - VAMC
 - NSICU
 - Child neurology



OU NEUROLOGY RESIDENCY: MMQI CASE CONFERENCES

ALL YEAR

- MMQI = morbidity, mortality, & quality improvement
- Meetings of faculty, residents, and fellows from the Department of Neurology (and other hospital health professionals) to discuss deaths, complications, medical errors, patient safety issues, and quality improvement issues concerning patients managed or co-managed by members of the department
- Monthly, 1st Fri, 12P-1:30P
- Cases are presented by residents & fellows
- Discussions focus on root cause analyses to identify systems, communication, or personal issues responsible for undesirable outcomes and strategies to prevent future undesirable outcomes



OU NEUROLOGY RESIDENCY: RESIDENT MEETINGS

ALL YEAR

- Meetings of all P2, P3, and P4 residents with the program director, associate program director, and program coordinator to discuss policies and resident concerns
- Monthly, 4th Fri 12P-1:30P
- Lunch provided by department



OU NEUROLOGY RESIDENCY:

ALL YEAR

OUMC & VAMC INPATIENT SERVICE MTGS

- Discussions of intraservice & interservice communication issues & quality improvement/process issues (focus on ACGME competencies “systems-based practice” and “practice-based learning and improvement”)
- Monthly, 1st Tue 12P
- VAMC service meetings on odd months
- OUMC service meetings on even months
- All residents, fellows, & service attendings attend
- Semiannual quality improvement (QI) reports by fellows or medical directors
 - VAMC – SEP, MAR
 - OUMC (Stroke & NI) – AUG, FEB
 - OUMC (NSICU) – OCT, APR

■ PD-Administrative Chief Resident Meetings

- Meetings between the two administrative chief residents & PD to discuss resident issues and concerns
- Monthly, 2nd Fri, 1:00 pm to 1:30 pm

■ PD-P3 Meetings

- Meetings between P3 residents & PD
- Quarterly

■ PD-P2 Meetings

- Meetings between P2 residents & PD
- Monthly, 3rd Fri, 1:00 pm to 1:30 pm

■ PD-P1 Meetings

- Meetings between P1 residents & PD
- Quarterly

- Neuropathology – P2 on rotation – ALL YEAR
 - Readings from Escourolle & Poirier Manual of Basic Neuropathology
 - Online slide programs and written quizzes
- Psychiatry – P2 rotating on psychiatry (JUL-DEC)
 - Readings from Kaplan & Saddock's Pocket Handbook of Clinical Psychiatry w/ quizzes
- Subspecialty clinic – P2 on rotation (JAN-JUN)
 - Assigned readings related to neurology subspecialty outpatient practice to help prepare for NEX
- VAMC neurorehabilitation – P4 on VAMC inpatient service
 - Mon 2:00P-2:30P; 1-on-1 w/faculty member on 6 of following topics:
 - Spasticity assessment/management
 - Hemiplegic shoulder pain
 - Neurogenic bowel/bladder
 - Rehabilitation of the SCI patient
 - TBI & postconcussive syndrome
 - Outcome measures in rehabilitation
 - PT, OT, & speech pathology
 - Neurorehabilitation modalities
 - Orthotic devices

- Focus on team building & residency program QI

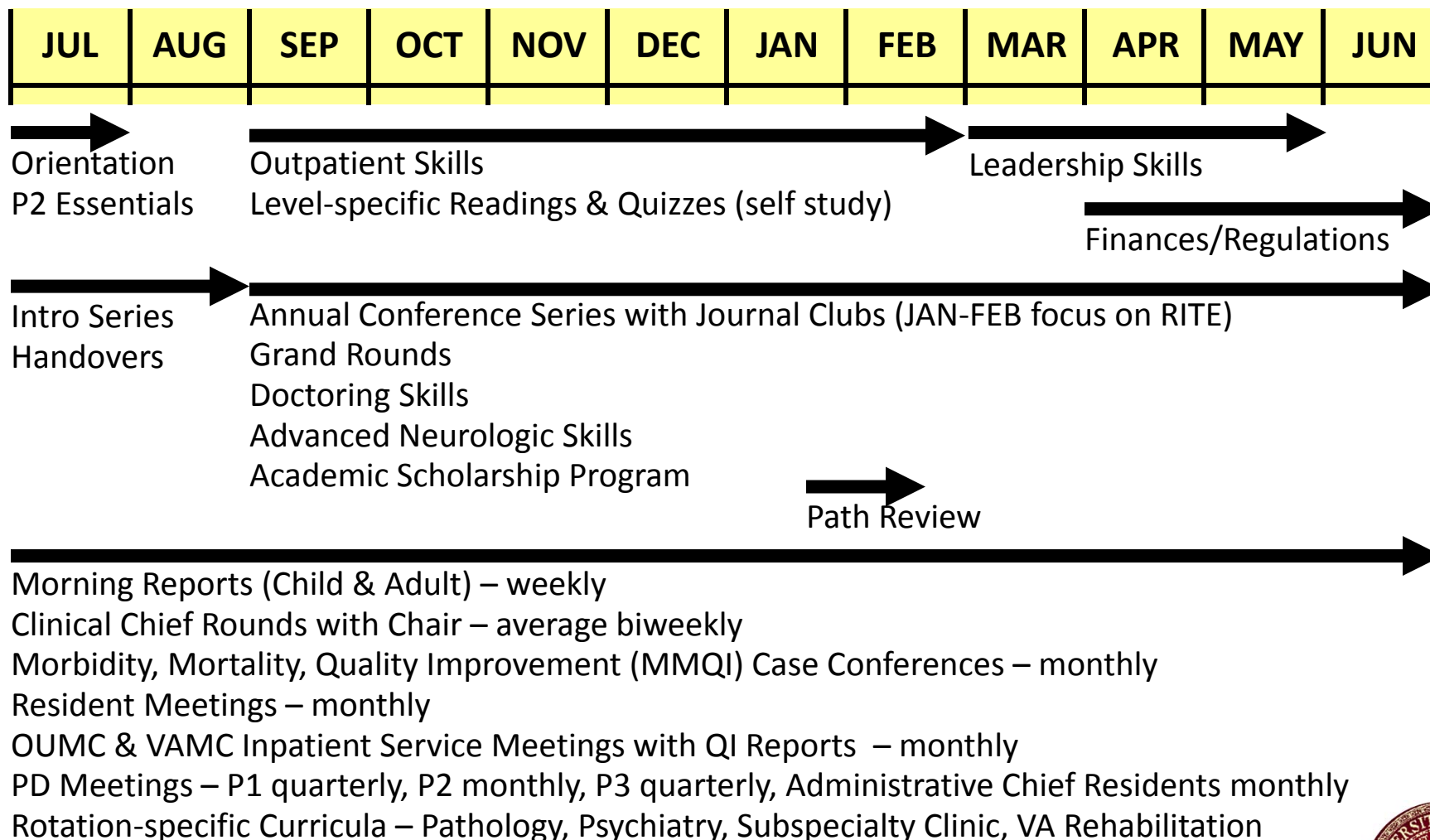
■ P3-P4 summit

OU NEUROLOGY RESIDENCY SUMMATIVE ASSESSMENTS

NEX SESSIONS

- Five sessions, preferably P3 year
 - 1-h clinical assessment in oral-boards format
 - ***ABPN stipulates 5 specific types of patients for NEX***
 - Resident cannot review chart or history in advance
 - Faculty observes w/o intervening (except for pt safety) x 1 h while resident performs Hx & Exam & counsels pt
 - After 1-h session, faculty may revise assessment, impression, & plan for pt as needed; after pt disposition, faculty sits w/ resident, probes resident's thought process on case, completes NEX form, provides feedback



OU NEUROLOGY RESIDENCY FORMATIVE ASSESSMENTS

SEMIANNUAL FEEDBACK SESSIONS

Individual resident milestones & meetings

- Clinical Competency Committee (CCC) Meetings
 - Meets bimonthly to discuss status and progress of each resident
 - Semiannually (NOV and MAY) evaluates the progress of each resident in terms of the 29 neurology milestones and reports its determinations to the ACGME
- Program Director / Chair Evaluations – JAN & JUN
 - Semiannual meetings w/ individual residents (20-min appts)
 - Review assessment results, student evaluations, RITE results, and CCC milestone determinations
 - Provide feedback based on above assessments & personal observations of program director & chair



OU NEUROLOGY RESIDENCY: “PAGER PROTECTION PROGRAM”

■ For all didactic sessions (8A & 12P):

➤ Prior to each session, residents:

- Put pagers on vibrate
- Place pagers in black box (making sure a secretary is present to answer pages)

➤ During each session

- Senior-most resident of each service answers all pages

➤ After each session

- Residents pick up pagers as soon as possible



OU NEUROLOGY RESIDENCY: MEDICAL STUDENT INVOLVEMENT

- P2 – ward teams (no evaluations), call, float
- P3 – child team (complete evaluations), float, WBL*
- P4 – ward teams (complete evaluations)

Teaching helps residents learn.

*Residents (1) mentor students while on call & inpatient service,
(2) find something to teach every night,
(3) complete ward & WBL evaluations with student present
& hand completed evaluations directly to student.*

**WBL = ward-based learning; formal exercise in clerkship; 2 sessions per 4-week clerkship, each involving half the students that rotation; occurs 2nd Tue and 3rd Thu each rotation, 1-5pm*
