CONFERENCE OVERVIEW

The Neonatal Nurse Practitioners, Neoflight, and Physicians of the Section of Perinatal-Neonatal Medicine at OU Health Sciences Center have developed this conference to provide an educational opportunity for those involved in neonatal care. This conference is designed to enhance the knowledge, tools, and skills of those that care for newborn and preterm infants.

Overall Goal: Provide comprehensive, up-to-date, state-of-the-art medical, nursing, and respiratory education focused on optimal care for neonatal patients.

Overall Objectives: At the end of the conference the participant will be able to:

- Discuss the effects of cannabinoid use during pregnancy and breast feeding.
- Describe new diagnostic and therapies for managing neonatal sepsis.
- Identify intervention to shorten hospital stays for infants with neonatal opiate withdrawal.
- Discuss outcomes for hypoglycemic infants treated with glucose gel.
- Discuss how and why one should be positive when everything seems to be negative.
- Discuss signs of pain and stress in the neonate, non-pharmacologic pain management interventions for all care team members, and long-term developmental consequences of chronic stress and pain in the neonate.
- Review the anatomy of an infant with hypoplastic left heart syndrome.
- Discuss different neonatal scenarios and their outcomes, presented in case presentations.
- Participate in active learning via poster presentations of recent clinical research and quality assurance projects addressing current medical, respiratory, and nursing management of high risk newborn infants.

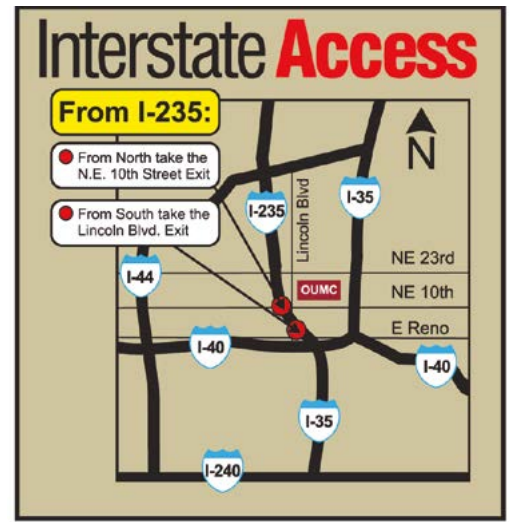
